The Boy from South Africa

Brad Binder comes from the heart of South Africa, from a land where the wind runs free and speed is a natural instinct. He grew up with the hunger of true racers — those who do not chase glory, but conquest. Every corner, every braking point, every overtake is an act of will.

You recognize him instantly in the paddock: a confident stride, a focused gaze, a smile that hides the ferocity of a fighter. Brad doesn't speak much, but when he climbs onto the KTM RC16 he becomes a universal language: the language of speed.

Fifteen Seasons in the World Championship, Seven in MotoGP

2026 marks his fifteenth season in the World Championship and his seventh in MotoGP — all of them lived with the same bike, the same family, the same faith: Red Bull KTM. A rare loyalty, almost romantic, that speaks louder than words.

Binder is not a rider who changes teams for convenience. Binder builds. And what he has built with KTM is one of the most powerful stories in modern MotoGP.

A Career Carved in Fire

- Moto3 (2016): World Champion. A perfect, fierce season, carved into memory.
- Moto2 (2017–2019): 8 victories, 15 podiums, a title narrowly missed.
- MotoGP (since 2020): the miracle of Brno — the first victory in KTM's history in the premier class. An achievement that sealed his place in legend.

That 2020 victory was not just a success: it was a declaration. The KTM RC16, ridden by a rookie, stole the spotlight from the giants. Brad opened a door no one else dared to push.
